Each year in March, at the Nacogdoches Pro Rodeo, the Nacogdoches Jaycees, in conjunction with the Nacogdoches Exposition Center awards one scholarship to a graduating senior student from each of the 8 public high schools in Nacogdoches County. Last year's scholarships were \$500 per student.

Scholarships are open to ALL graduating seniors in public schools and are designed to help a deserving student further his or her life's ambition. They are not restricted to academic achievement only and take into account agriculture related activities as well as religious and community service activities. Also, these scholarships are not limited to attendance at a college or university, but may be used to attend accredited technical training schools (like TSTI) or specialized training academies (such as fire or police).

Please find attached a copy of the 2024 Scholarship Application Form which you may duplicate and hand out in your school to prospective 2024 graduates.
