## RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a bona fide Nacogdoches County 4-H, Jr. FFA, or FFA member, be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through 12th grade of a public K12 or private school in Nacogdoches County, from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS; or, be a home schooled student in an accredited cooperative program that has a physical address within Nacogdoches County, which must be verified by an official of the Cooperative, and be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through the 12th grade from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS.
- 3) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from pick-up date through the end of the show.
- 4) All broilers exhibited Wednesday, October 9, 2024 must be bought from the Nacogdoches County Youth Livestock Association at cost. Only those birds banded by the Nacogdoches County Youth Livestock Association will be accepted and must still have the original wing band in place or bird will be disqualified.
- 5) Orders are placed in increments of 40. Each exhibitor may order 1 box (40 birds) or 2 boxes (80 birds) **OR** siblings within the same household may order and share a set of 2 boxes (80 birds). A family with multiple exhibitors can order an individual set of birds (1 or 2 boxes) for each exhibitor in the family, **OR** if they wish, they can order 1 set (2 boxes) for the entire family. <u>The MAXIUMUM number of birds in a set that an exhibitor can select from for the show is 80 birds</u>. \*\*Families with multiple exhibitors are NOT required to place a single order for the entire family, but each exhibitor may only show birds from their specific set. Family order is an option.
- 6) Broiler entries are limited to one pen per exhibitor. Each pen of three (3) birds must pass the sifting committee. Each exhibitor may bring three (3) birds plus one (1) designated alternate bird to the sifting. Birds can be brought one time only.
- 7) Judging begins at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 concluding with the selection of the Grand and Reserve Champions followed by the sale order selection.
- 8) Market animals selected for a drug test must complete the test immediately following the sale order selection on Wednesday, October 9, 2024.
- 9) The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 12, 2024 at 6:00 pm. ALL lots will be exhibitor only.
- 10) All broilers arriving on the fairgrounds will become property of the Nacogdoches County Youth Livestock Association.
- 11) All exhibitors must supply feeders, feed, and water.
