RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a bona fide Nacogdoches County 4-H, Jr. FFA, or FFA member, be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through 12th grade of a public K12 or private school in Nacogdoches County, from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS; or, be a home schooled student in an accredited cooperative program that has a physical address within Nacogdoches County, which must be verified by an official of the Cooperative, and be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through the 12th grade from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS.
- 3) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from pick-up date through the end of the show.
- 4) All broilers exhibited Wednesday, October 9, 2024 must be bought from the Nacogdoches County Youth Livestock Association at cost. All Broilers must have original wing band in place or birds will be disqualified.
- 5) **Orders are placed in increments of 25. A minimum order per exhibitor or family unit is 25 chicks, and up to a maximum of 75 chicks. Therefore, each exhibitor or family may order 25, 50 or 75 chicks. Each exhibitor MAY order an individual set of birds (up to 75) OR siblings within the same household may order and share a set of birds (up to 75). In other words, a family with multiple exhibitors can order an individual set of birds for each exhibitor in the family, OR if they wish, they can order one set of birds for the entire family. In either case, the maximum number of birds in a set that an exhibitor can select from for the show is 75 birds. This rule is the same for the HLSR, SASSR and RA shows. Please note: families with multiple exhibitors are NOT required to place a single order for the entire family. Family orders are an option.**
- 6) Judging begins at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 concluding with the selection of the Grand and Reserve Champions followed by the sale order selection.
- 7) Market animals selected for a drug test must complete the test immediately following the sale order selection on Wednesday, October 9, 2024.
- 8) The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 12, 2024 at 6:00 pm. ALL lots will be exhibitor only.
- 9) All broilers arriving on the fairgrounds will become property of the Nacogdoches County Youth Livestock Association.
- 10) All exhibitors must supply feeders, feed, and water.
