## RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a bona fide Nacogdoches County 4-H, Jr. FFA, or FFA member, be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through 12th grade of a public K12 or private school in Nacogdoches County, from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS; or, be a home schooled student in an accredited cooperative program that has a physical address within Nacogdoches County, which must be verified by an official of the Cooperative, and be continuously enrolled in or entering the 3rd through the 12th grade from the required date of validation through the conclusion of either the PWF or NCSS.
- 3) This class is open to Wether goats only.
- 4) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from validation through the end of the show. Exhibitor must maintain control of their animal at all times in and out of the show ring.
- 5) All goats must have been validated on Saturday, June 22, 2024 at the Nacogdoches County Expo between 6:00 - 9:00 A.M. AS PER SHOW RULES. Exhibitors may validate multiple animals; however, only (1) goat per exhibitor may be brought to the show grounds.
- 6) All Market Goats must be dehorned or have horn tipped prior to weigh in at show. Ends of tipped horns must be larger than a dime in diameter.
- 7) All Market Goats must be sheared above the knees and hock joints prior to entering the show for judging.
- 8) Exhibitors are responsible for turning in **weight card by 5:00 PM on Thursday October 10, 2024**. Validation forms will be checked on Thursday, October 10, 2024 from 4:00 till 5:00 PM. Goats must weigh between 50 lbs to 130 lbs. They will be sifted by weight and classes will be divided as evenly as possible by weight.
- 9) A minimum of four (4) top placing Goats in each class will be subject to a weigh back. Any Goat weighing more than 5 lbs over official weigh in weight will be allowed to weigh one addition time before being disqualified.
- 10) Judging begins at immediately concluding the lamb show on Friday, October 11, 2024 concluding with the selection of Grand & Reserve Champions followed by the sale order selection of class winners and other remaining placing premium sale goats. Showmanship will follow the conclusion of the premium sale selection. All goats will be released at the conclusion of the show.
- 11) Showmanship Divisions (Ages are as of the day of the show):  
Junior: 13 years and Under      Senior: 14 years and Over      Pee Wee: 8 years and Under and not entered in this show  
Each exhibitor must exhibit his/her entry in Showmanship Classes, Pee Wee must use a goat exhibited in the show.
- 12) The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 12, 2024 at 6:00 pm. Grand and Reserve Champion goats ONLY will need to be present for the premium sale. All other lots will be the exhibitor only.
- 13) A market resale will not be held; each exhibitor is responsible for the resale of their animal and for the care of their animal until it reaches final destination. All animals must be removed from fairgrounds by noon Sunday, October 13th.
- 14) Market animals selected for a drug test must complete the test immediately following the sale order selection on Friday, October 11, 2024.
- 15) Shavings must be purchased from the Nacogdoches County Expo Center. No other type of bedding will be allowed.
- 16) Goats will be disqualified for: a) a non-legible tattoo, b) description of goat differs from validation form, c) exhibitor fails to provide proper documentation and signatures on validation form.
