RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) All entries will be subject to the General Rules & Regulations of the Junior Livestock Show.
- 2) Exhibitor must be a Nacogdoches County 4-H, FFA, and FCCLA member and continuously attend school in Nacogdoches County or be home schooled and reside within the boundaries of a school district in Nacogdoches County; and be at the 12th grade level or below from validation through the end of the show.
- 3) This is a carrier show. All animals must be in a solid bottom, leak proof carrier.
- 4) All entries must be under the care of and fed by the exhibitor from validation through the end of the show.
- 5) All Market Rabbit entries must have been validated on Thursday, September 1, 2016 at the Nacogdoches County Expo & Civic Center between 4:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. AS PER SHOW RULES, and receive an ear validation rag in order to be eligible to exhibit in the 2016 Pineywoods Fair.
- 6) **WEIGHT LIMIT:** A pen will be three (3) rabbits of either sex, all the same breed and variety. Entries must not weigh less than three (3) lbs. or more than five (5) lbs. (within one (1) ounce tolerance). No substitutes are allowed.
- 7) Judging will begin immediately after the Junior Breeding Rabbit Show, Thursday, October 13, 2016, concluding with the selection of the Grand & Reserve Champions and sale order selection which will be 10 points less than other Market Shows. All entries not selected for the premium sale will be released immediately following the show. The Premium Sale will be held Saturday, October 15, 2016 at 6:00 P.M.
- 8) Shavings may be purchased from the Nacogdoches County Expo Center. No other type of bedding will be allowed.
- 9) Rabbits will be disqualified for: a) ear canker, b) sore hocks, c) buck teeth, d) any other obvious disease, f) exhibitor fails to provide proper documentation and signatures on validation form. Any sick animals will be removed from the show at the discretion of the committee.
- 10) Market animals selected for a drug test must complete the test before leaving the fairgrounds on Thursday, October 13, 2016.
- 11) The decision of the judge will be final.
